Lollipop

The first incarnation of the lollipop was probably created by cave people thousands of years ago who (34) honey from beehives with a stick. No wanting to waste the honey, they most likely licked the stick and invented the world's first lollipop.

In the 17th century, as sugar became more plentiful, the English enjoyed boiled sugar candy treats and inserted sticks into them to make them easier to eat. However, as more and more people start to pay high attention on keeping healthy, “Zollipop” the sugar-free candies came out.
