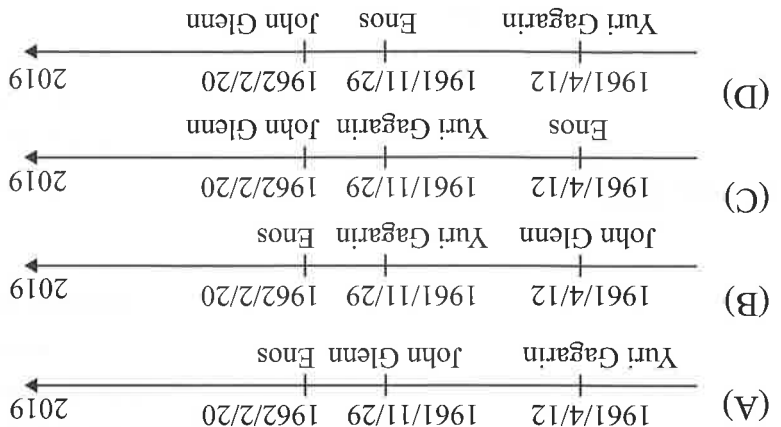

How many hours a day do you stay at school? Students in England go to school for 6.5 hours a day, and so do students in the USA. Students in Japan stay at school for 6 hours, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Students in Taiwan spend 9.5 hours at school, from 7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m., the longest school hours around the world. What do students in Taiwan do most often at school? They take a lot of tests, one after another, every day. However, is it really good for them to spend so much time at school and on tests?

Some people in Taiwan think that it may be better to cut down on the school hours. Less time at school means more time for family, friends, and hobbies. Also, knowledge is everywhere, not only in textbooks. It is better for students to experience all kinds of things in real life.

Tests are important, but spending too much time on them might not do students good. They may get less healthy and become less happy. On the other hand, some people believe that tests improve memory in some good ways. Tests are also a useful way to help teachers understand whether their students have learned what is taught in class.
