The 88th Oscars had some serious problems. First, its list of nominees was criticized as too “white” because black nominees are nowhere to be seen. The host made a lot of fun about this many times, but he didn’t seem to realize the real problem. Then he made a racist joke about Asians: he invited three Asian kids to stand next to him and told people that these kids are good at math and hard-working. He also said they could even make the phones in our hands, too.

Jeremy Lin, an Asian NBA player, took the lead in criticizing the stereotype discrimination. He left a message on Twitter, “Seriously though, when is this going to change?” Ang Lee later joined his lead, saying it’s not cool for the host to do that. The Academy felt the pressure, and to calm down people, they said sorry for the bad joke. Jeremy Lin was tired of the fact that people think it is cool or funny to treat Asians in such a bad way. When interviewed, he said that it was the right time to speak up for Asians. “The way Asians have been stereotyped is disappointing,” said Lin. Lin said he is used to racist comments, and he has faced discrimination since he decided to play basketball. Because of his skin color, he had no chance of going to his dream university even though he had already been a star player in high school.

In fact, Jeremy was not chosen by the NBA at first, and some people believed that it was because of his skin color and how Asians are stereotyped. Yet with Lin’s effort and lots of practice, he finally got the chance to play in the NBA and brought the “Linsanity 2012” to New York.




